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GETTING READY FOR CLASS

1. Prepare a lecture plan
2. Read daily news
3. Have a look at Financial Times
4. Extra questions ready on hand
5. Finish each section at the same topic
6. If students are bored, stop and talk about daily news for 5 mins
7. Explain things as simple as possible

CONFIDENCE

- Be confident about the topic.
- Demand respect from students.
- Attention on outfit- casual or smart.
- Get feedback from students: speed of the lecture, extra examples, revision etc.

MY TEACHING PHYLOSOPHY

- A teacher learns as he/she teaches.
- A great teacher is like a great artist.
- Teaching is not just transferring information but share passion for knowledge, inspire students creativity and develop critical thinking.
- Student oriented teaching.

MY PRINCIPALS OF GOOD TEACHING

1. *Passion:* How well the students can learn greatly depends on how passionate and how devoted a teacher is.
2. *Critical thinking:* a teacher should encourage critical thinking and should always strive to be respectful of different opinions. Students, on the other hand, should learn to think independently, not merely accept the teacher's opinions. A teacher should be prepared to challenge and be challenged by the students
3. *Culture:* English abilities, cultural backgrounds and fundamental knowledge may vary greatly.
4. *Course materials:* computer based technology such as multimedia, slides, and the Internet, is an effective way to complement traditional lectures, online quizzes, online games where applicable and exams.

MY TEACHING METHODS

1. Good preparation for a well structured lecture with many examples.
2. Incorporate interesting news, financial developments and recent regulatory changes into the topic.
3. Aim to help students to see the larger picture.
4. Teach things very clear.
5. I use powerpoint slides and whiteboard.

MY TEACHING METHODS

6. I spend 1 lecture to review course material and 1 lecture to solve problems.
7. I summarise the previous lecture on the whiteboard at the beginning of each lecture.
8. Motivate students to use my office hours.
9. Be prompt on answering questions and emails.
10. Be reachable and cooperative. I am here to help.... 😊
